



## PROFESSIONAL EDUCATION FOR SAI AUDITORS – PILOT

Professional Auditor. Professional SAI.



### WHY DO WE NEED PESA?



- Citizens need well functioning SAIs. Professional staff able to deliver high quality audits in the public interest.



- SAI Auditor recruited from University. He needs a comprehensive technical base for SAI audits.



- SAI Auditors who need to align their work to ISSAI requirements.



- New SAI Auditor recruited from the private sector. She needs to understand SAI context, professional judgement and auditing in the public interest.

### HOW DO WE MEET THIS NEED?

The framework is based on an innovative concept of EAR (Education Assessment Reflection), while providing equal emphasis on education and assessment of competencies. PESA pilot will provide opportunities for "reflection" throughout the process.

#### **E** EDUCATION

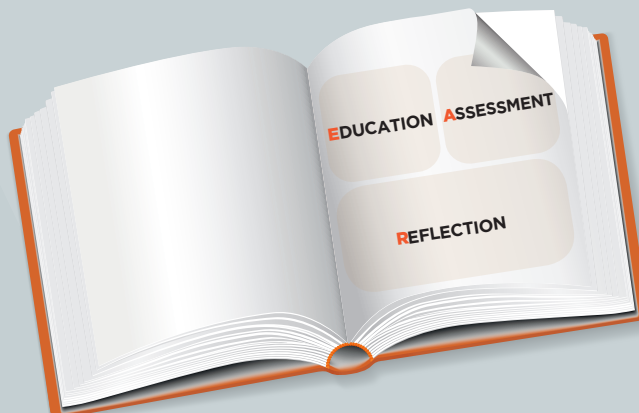
The PESA (pilot) provides for education in digital format with face to face and social learning options. Education will be based on a syllabus, which covers the INTOSAI competency framework for auditors. The education will focus on universal competencies that are applicable in the SAI community.

#### **A** ASSESSMENT

We will get assurance that the auditors demonstrate required competencies through a robust assessment process. The process will include computer-marked assessments and an initial professional development portfolio developed by participants based on the application of their education in SAI context.

#### **R** REFLECTION

The last and most important element of the EAR framework is – reflection. Ability to exercise professional judgement is the most critical competency demonstrated by a professional auditor. Both the education initiative and the assessments will provide opportunities for reflection to enable auditors to hone their ability to exercise professional judgement.



## WHAT COMPETENCIES DOES A SAI AUDITOR NEED?

### T-SHAPED SYLLABUS



**A total of 70 hours**

Cross-cutting (20 hours) + audit stream (50 hours)

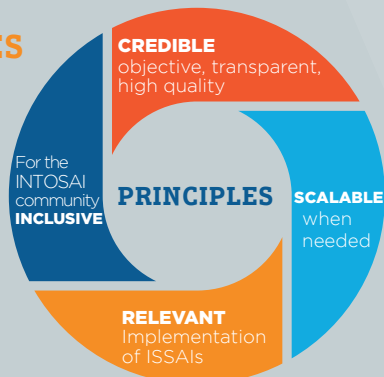
Based on the INTOSAI Competency framework for public sector audit professionals.

The horizontal bar of the T has been defined as cross-cutting competencies that are universally applicable and form the essence of any public sector audit professional in a SAI, e.g. acts in public interest.

The vertical bar of the T defines the specific audit-related competencies, e.g. competencies in compliance auditing.
